Anne Mattocks Strieber (August 25, 1946 – August 11, 2015) was an American author, well known for her thrillers *An Invisible Woman* (2004) and *Little Town Lies* (2005).^[1]

Biography

Before becoming a writer she was a schoolteacher. She married fellow novelist, Whitley Strieber; they have one son, Andrew.

She was the managing editor of her husband's Web site, unknowncountry.com,^[2] and was also a host of the *Dreamland* radio show podcast hosted there.

She was portrayed by Lindsay Crouse in the film adaptation of her husband's nonfiction work *Communion*.

Anne Strieber died on August 11, 2015.^{[3][4]}
