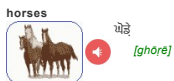
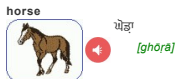
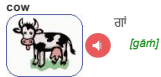
Plural Grammar Rules

The plural is the form which refers to more than one object or person. For example: I **speak two languages** the plural here is *[languages]* because it refers to more than one *[language]*. The examples below use plurals in different ways and places to demonstrate how they look when converted from their singular form.

Grammar + Rules - Punjabi + Pronunciation
<p>I speak one language <i>[singular form]</i> ਮੈਂ ਇੱਕ ਭਾਸ਼ਾ ਬੋਲਦਾ ਹਾਂ ▶ <i>[maiñ ika bhāśā bōladā hān]</i></p>
<p>we speak three languages <i>[plural noun]</i> ਅਸੀਂ ਤਿੰਨ ਭਾਸ਼ਾਵਾਂ ਬੋਲਦੇ ਹਾਂ ▶ <i>[asīñ tina bhāśāvāñ bōladē hāñ]</i></p>
<p>he visits many countries <i>[adverb + plural noun]</i> ਉਹ ਕਈ ਮੁਲਕਾਂ 'ਚ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ ▶ <i>[ōha kaī mulakāñ 'ca jāndā hai]</i></p>
<p>they are happy now <i>[plural pronoun]</i> ਉਹ ਹੁਣ ਖੁਸ਼ ਹਨ ▶ <i>[ōha huñ khusā hana]</i></p>
<p>she has five red shoes <i>[adjective + plural noun]</i> ਉਸ ਕੁਝੀ ਵੇਲ ਪੰਜ ਲਾਲ ਬੂਟ ਹਨ ▶ <i>[ōsa kufī vēl pañ lālā būṭa hana]</i></p>
<p>I want a sandwich without onions <i>[preposition + plural noun]</i> ਮੈਂ ਬਗੈਰ ਪਿਆਜ਼ ਦਾ ਸੈਂਡਵਿਚ ਚਿੱਠੀ ▶ <i>[mainū bagaira pi'āza dā sainḍavica dī'ō]</i></p>

The following is a list of examples showing both the singular and plural form. This demonstrates how the plural is used with humans, objects and animals.

woman	▶ ਐਰਤ <i>[aurata]</i>
women	▶ ਐਰਤਾਂ <i>[auratān]</i>
man	▶ ਮਰਦ <i>[marada]</i>
men	▶ ਮਰਦ <i>[marada]</i>
house	▶ ਘਰ <i>[ghara]</i>
houses	▶ ਘਰ <i>[ghara]</i>
cup	▶ ਪਿਆਲਾ <i>[pi'ala]</i>
cups	▶ ਪਿਆਲੇ <i>[pi'ale]</i>



Emergency Phrases

Now it's time to practice your Punjabi by looking at these phrases which are related to emergencies. Be prepared when traveling abroad, just in case you need help or by offering help to someone else. I recommend writing these expressions down on a notebook before traveling.

English - Punjabi - Pronunciation
Help ਮਦਦ [madada]
Call the ambulance ਐਂਬੂਲੈਂਸ ਸੱਦੇ [aimbūlnaiṁsa sadō]
I need a doctor ਮੈਂ ਡਾਕਟਰ ਦੀ ਲੋੜ ਹੈ [mainū dākatara dī lōṛa hai]
Where is the closest pharmacy? ਨੇੜੇ ਦਵਾਈਆਂ ਦੀ ਦੁਕਾਨ ਕਿੱਥੇ ਹੈ? [nēṛē dāvāīān dī dukāna kithē hai?]
Are you okay? ਕੀ ਤੁਸੀਂ ਠੀਕ ਹੋ? [kī tusīn ṭhīka hō?]
I am sick ਮੈਂ ਬਿਮਾਰ ਹਾਂ [māim bimāra hām]
Call the police ਪੁਲਿਸ ਨੂੰ ਸੱਦੇ [pulisa nū sadō]
