Etymology 1

From Middle Persian *dyn'* (*dēn*), from Old Persian or Avestan 𐬀𐬎𐬎𐬀 (*daēnā*, “religion, vision”), ultimately from Proto-Indo-Iranian **d^hayHanā-* (compare Sanskrit ध्यान (*dhyāna*)). The broken plural ادیان (*adyân*) is borrowed from Arabic أديان (*'adyān*), plural of دين (*dīn*).
